





The Programme in a nutshell

Med is a transnational cooperation Interreg Programme, that involves 13 European countries from the Northern shore of the Mediterranean, working together for a sustainable growth in the region.

The role of the Emilia-Romagna Region

In 2016 the Conference of the Italian Regions nominated the Emilia-Romagna Region as **Co-president of the National authority** of Med and attributed it the role of **National contact point**.

Moreover, the ER Region gives technical assistance to the beneficiaries involved in the projects.

As Co-president, it contributes and ensures the involvement of the Italian Regions in the Med Programme and supports the coordination and the definition of the national position that Italian representatives present to the Monitoring committee of the Programme. Furthermore, it guarantees its collaboration with the other members of the Italian national coordination unit, namely:

- Council of Ministers, Department of cohesion policies – Co-presidency
- Agency for territorial cohesion – Co-presidency

National committee

It is composed by 19 Italian Regions and the Italian stakeholders. It accepts and shares all the recommendations from the Managing authority. It is called in by the Co-president (Emilia-Romagna Region) in agreement with the Department of cohesion of the Italian Government and the Italian Agency for territorial cohesion. Decisions are made by consensus. Periodically the Co-president, together with the Italian Agency for territorial cohesion, updates the whole National committee about the Panoramed project, regarding the governance for the Mediterranean area.
